

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Route #58, which services the Sunrise Ski Area from the Apache Enterprise Sunrise Service Station to the parking areas of the ski area, has had problems in previous seasons receiving adequate snow removal and cinder spreading; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau has offered to accept a "BUY INDIAN" Contract from Sunrise to do the maintenance of the road, pursuant to which Sunrise would provide, for a fee paid by the BIA, labor, fuel, and maintenance on vehicles supplied by the Bureau to accomplish the job; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has requested that the tribal resolution be initiated in order to expedite this "BUY INDIAN" Contract so that current snow removal needs can be completed on a timely basis by Sunrise employees; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the "BUY INDIAN" Contract have not yet been concluded this date, but that an urgent need for this service already exists.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby affirms the urgent need for this "BUY INDIAN" Contract, so that public patrons of the Apache Sunrise Ski Area can have easy access on its roads and thereby enhance the successful operation of the Ski Area.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by

the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
