- WHEREAS, Jess and Josephine Smith of San Carlos have already been chosen and they have officially accepted their role of Godparents; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held in East Fork.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Ronnie and Vera (Cruz) Lupe, Sponsors, and Jess and Josephine Smith, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of July 17, 18, 19, 1987, at East Fork.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JANUARY 7, 1987</u>, duly adopted by vote of <u>10</u> for and <u>0</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 28, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
