- WHEREAS, Maybelline and Elliott Mason of Cibecue Community have already been chosen and they have officially accepted their role of Godparents; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the neccessary ceremonial activities to be held at Alchesay Flat of North Fork;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Audie and Nancy (Alchesay) Skidmore, Sponsors, and Maybelline and Elliott Mason, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Sherrie Lynn Skidmore during the weekend of June 13, 14, 1987, in North Fork at Alchesay Flat.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JANUARY 7, 1987</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>10</u> for and <u>0</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
