FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council on December 4, 1986, enacted Ordinance No. 153 which is an amendment to Tribal Ordinance No. 60, after the Ordinance was duly considered and posted for the required period of time; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that following its enactment the Ordinance was not forwarded to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for secretarial approval within the required time; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to reaffirm Resolution No. 86-384 which enacted Ordinance No. 153.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms Resolution No. 86-384 in its entirety.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i,o) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
