

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Carla (Alchesay) Nachu, the Director of Whiteriver Hospital and Susan Oliver, Director of Indian Health Service Social Services has presented information to the Tribal Council in regards to efforts being made by the Indian Health Service to educate the public about Child Abuse on the reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has expressed intense interest in this area and commends the initiative taken by Indian Health Service Social Services in their attempts to educate and ameliorate this social problem; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there is on-going inter tribal-agency activity to cope with child abuse involving Indian Health Service and Tribal Social Service and Law Enforcement Agencies; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council endorses the activities of IHS and Tribal agencies to cope with the problems of child abuse.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby acknowledges and commends the initiative taken by Tribal Agencies and the Indian Health Service in their attempts to educate the public about child abuse through their respective programs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby supports and urges all tribal Law Enforcement and Social Services Agencies to continue their cooperative efforts with Indian Health Service to eliminate this problem on the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on January 8, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
