RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been presented with figures obtained from the Bureau of Indian Affairs Office in Albuquerque pertaining to the Tribe's share of highway trust funds for roads development on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and
- WHEREAS, the figures show that the White Mountain Apache Tribe is still owed approximately \$100,000 of its share of highway trust funds which have not been allocated or expended on behalf of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the percentage of funds allocated to the White Mountain Apache Tribe is less than the percentage allocated and expended by other tribes, the majority of which exceed their percentage quota; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requests the Director of the Phoenix Area Office, Jim Stevens, to inquire as to the location of the approximately \$100,000 highway trust funds and report back to the Tribal Council through the Office of the Tribal Chairman an accounting as to these funds.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that Mr. Jim Stevens, Director of the Phoenix Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, provide the White Mountain Apache Tribe through the Office of the Tribal Chairman, an accounting of the approximately \$100,000 in highway funds allocated but not disbursed to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, as well as an accounting of the past year's use of road construction funds for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on January 8, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
