


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Miss Linda Kay Lupe, Miss White Mountain Apache for 1986/87, has recommended to the Tribal Council that the guidelines for the Tribal Queen and Queen Committee drafted in 1977 be revised and updated as portions of the guidelines have never been followed, initiated or are presently inappropriate; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Miss Lupe should coordinate closely with the Office of the Tribal Chairman in revising the guidelines for future presentation to and approval by the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that Miss Linda Kay Lupe, Miss White Mountain Apache for 1986/87, meet with the Tribal Chairman for the purpose of revising and updating the guidelines for the Tribal Queen Committee and that thereafter she report back to the Tribal Council with her recommendations for revisions of the Tribal Queen and Queen Committee guidelines.


The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i,s,g) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
