WHEREAS, Wesley and Beverly (Tenijieth) Malone, have requested approval of the Tribal Council for them to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for their daughter during the weekend of June 19, 20, 21, 1987; and

WHEREAS, Oney and Dena Ann (Johnson) Massey of East Fork Community have already been chosen and they have officially accepted their role of Godparents; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held in Whiteriver at the old tribal fairgrounds.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Wesley and Beverly (Tenijieth) Malone, Sponsors, and Oney and Dena Ann (Johnson) Massey, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of June 19, 20, 21, 1987, in Whiteriver at the old tribal fairgrounds.


