## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council pursuant to Resolution No. 86-127, designated certain gratuitous right-of-ways for housing access roads, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised by tribal member, Noline Clay, that implementation of the third "whereas clause" of Resolution No. 86-127, specifically the present route of Reno Johnson Drive, will result in a road crossing through the middle of his homesite property; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requested by Mr. Clay to re-route the road so it will not bisect or cross his property; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with this request and concludes that a Change Order should be immediately processed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs to re-route the right-of-way known as Reno Johnson Drive in such a way as not to cross Mr. Clay's property, and that such re-routing should be done in the least expensive manner without further conflicts with lands assigned to tribal members.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby amends Resolution No. 86-127, specifically the third "whereas clause", by directing that Reno Johnson Drive be re-routed in such a way so as not to cross Noline Clay's homesite property and hereby directs the Bureau of Indian Affairs to process a Change Order to re-route Reno Johnson Drive to accomplish the foregoing amendment.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the remainder of Resolution No. 86-127 shall remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was on January 14, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
