RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous resolution directed that the Tribal Attorney draft a proposed revision of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Code; and
- WHEREAS, said revisions has been posted for several months for public comment and discussion; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed one section of the Code entitled proposed White Mountain Apache Government Code in the form attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has thoroughly reviewed and discussed the contents of said Government Code and concludes that it should be enacted as presented.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves final passage and enactment this date of the White Mountain Apache Government Code in the form attached hereto.

The foregoing resolution was on January 14, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i,p.q,r,t,u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
