- WHEREAS, Homer and Alta (Ethelbah) Fall parents of Rettalynn Fall have requested approval of the Tribal Council for them to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for their daughter during the weekend of June 27, 28, 1987; and
- WHEREAS, Bennett and Joyce Stevens of San Carlos have already been chosen and they have officially accepted their role of Godparents; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the old tribal fair-grounds in Whiteriver.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Homer and Alta
 (Ethelbah) FAll, Sponsors, and Bennett and Joyce Stevens,
 Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance
 for Rettalynn Fall during the weekend of June 27, 28,
 1987, at the old tribal fairgrounds in Whiteriver.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary notify the Whiteriver Police Department of this and all other Sunrise Dance Ceremonies so that adequate Officer scheduling can be arranged.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JANUARY 15, 1987</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE for and ZERO against</u> by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by ARticle V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
