RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, by previous resolution, adopted an Education Code for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, commonly known as the Truancy Code; and
- WHEREAS, said Code has been previously passed by the Tribal Council and approved pursuant to constitutional procedures; and
- WHEREAS, the Code has been codified for inclusion in an overall revision of the Tribal Code, but that no substantive changes have been made to the Education Code; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the Education code should remain unchanged at this time and should be codified as is into the new Tribal Code revision.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves this date the codification of the Tribal Education Code without change.

The foregoing resolution was on January 22, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
