

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Member, Gus Quintero, has come before the Tribal Council and requested approval to sponsor a Sunrise Dance for his daughter on June 19 & 20, 1987, at the Old Tribal Fairgrounds; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that this particular date conflicts with a Sunrise Dance already approved by the Tribal Council; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussion, approves the request of Mr. Quintero to sponsor a Sunrise Dance and requests that he meet with the Tribal Council Secretary to select a date which will not conflict with other prior approved Sunrise Dances.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves Mr. Gus Quintero's request that he be allowed to sponsor a Sunrise Dance at the Old Tribal Fairgrounds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests that Mr. Quintero meet with the Tribal Council Secretary to select a date for the Sunrise Dance which will not conflict with Sunrise Dances which have already been approved by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
