WHEREAS, Elena Baha has already been chosen and she has officially accepted the role of Godparent; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held in Whiteriver at the old Tribal Fairgrounds.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Betty and Matthew Tortice and Nelson Jr. and Rezona Lupe, Sponsors, and Elena Baha, Godparent, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Bettina Dillon during the weekend of May 23, 24, 25, 1987, in Whiteriver at the old Tribal Fairgrounds.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(g)&(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
