FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Greta and Earl Ethelbah, parents of Earlita Ethelbah, have requested approval of the Tribal Council for them to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for their daughter during the weekend of September 5, 6, 7, 1987; and

WHEREAS, Donner and Shirley Clawson have already been chosen and they have officially accepted their role of Godparents; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held in Whiteriver at the old Tribal Fairgrounds.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Greta and Earl Ethelbah, Sponsors, and Donner and Shirley Clawson, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Earlita Ethelbah during the weekend of September 5, 6, 7, 1987, in Whiteriver at the old Tribal Fairgrounds.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(g)&(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
