- WHEREAS, the Grievance Committee has also selected Delores Palmer as a fifth committee member to serve as the committee must consist of five members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by prior Resolution No. 86-294, directed the Grievance Committee members to chose five alternate members to serve as needed in Grievance Committee proceedings; and
- WHEREAS, the Grievance Committee has proposed to the Tribal Council the following names of individuals who are willing to serve as alternates on the Grievance Committee: Wesley Bonito, Lloyd Susan, and Frances Bybee; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed these names and is of the opinion that each of the named individuals is capable of serving as an alternate on the Grievance Committee.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following individuals are appointed to serve as alternates on the Tribal Grievance Committee: Wesley Bonito, Lloyd Susan, and Frances Bybee.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of $\underline{\text{NINE}}$ for and $\underline{\text{ZERO}}$ against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to

authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i,s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
