- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council after discussion, concludes that the term of the recently appointed Fair Commission members should be clarified for members of the public; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the recently appointed Fair Commission members should serve through the 1988 Tribal Fair.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reconfirms that the recently appointed Fair Commission members shall serve through the 1988 Tribal Fair.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i,s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
