

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous resolution, directed that amendments to the Rules of Civil, Criminal and Appellate Procedures be posted for a period of at least ten days pursuant to requirements of the Tribal Constitution and Bylaws so that members of the public could comment on the proposed amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Rules of Civil, Criminal and Appellate Procedures as amended have been so posted, that more than ten days have transpired, and that no public comment has been received opposing final passage; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that final passage of the Rules of Civil, Criminal and Appellate Procedures as amended and posted should proceed.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves final enactment of the Rules of Civil, Criminal and Appellate Procedures as amended, effective immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on February 18, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i,q) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
