

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Orin and Sally Nashio have requested Tribal Council approval to conduct a Sunrise Ceremony for their daughter, Shelley Marie Nashio, at the Old Tribal Fairgrounds in Whiteriver, on August 7, 8 & 9, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the sponsoring godparents are Stanley and Eunice Pinal; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that August 7, 8 & 9, 1987 should be reserved for Mr. and Mrs. Nashio for the Sunrise Ceremony for their daughter, Shelley Marie Nashio.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the holding of a Sunrise Dance Ceremony on behalf of Shelley Marie Nashio, at the Whiteriver Old Tribal Fairgrounds, on August 7, 8 & 9, 1987.

The foregoing resolution was on February 19, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
