RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the recent retirement of Dr. George Blue Spruce as Director of the Phoenix Area Office of the Indian Health Service has created a vacancy in that position, which vacancy the Indian Health Service is now attempting to fill; and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has asked the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for its recommendation as to a suitable candidate to fill the position of Area Director, and has submitted to the Tribal Council a list of eligible candidates; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the list of candidates and after discussion, has determined that Mr. John Bruenger is the most acceptable candidate and should be appointed as Director of the Phoenix Area Office of the Indian Health Service.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recommends that Mr. John Bruenger be appointed as Director of the Phoenix Area Office of the Indian Health Service.

The foregoing resolution was on March 19, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
