## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that there is a need to revise tribal Resolution No. 86-220 which appointed the following members to the HIP Advisory Committee: Charlene Hill, Valita Hastings, Vonda Clarkson, Gwen Gloshay, and Verna Tessay, and
- WHEREAS, resignations from the HIP Committee have necessitated the appointment of alternate members to the committee; and
- WHEREAS, the names of qualified individuals have been submitted to the Council and after review, the Council is of the opinion that Charlene Hill should remain on the committee, and that Valita Hastings should take the place of Bettina Begay who has resigned her position, and that Vonda Clarkson, Gwen Gloshay, and Verna Tessay should continue their membership on the HIP Committee.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the HIP Advisory Committee is appointed as follows; Charlene Hill, Valita Hastings, Vonda Clarkson, Gwen Gloshay and Verna Tessay.
- The foregoing resolution was on MARCH 19, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and TWO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the

Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
