

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal member, Cyrilla (Moody) Bead, has requested the Tribal Council's assistance in placing her name on an eligibility list for a HUD home;

WHEREAS, she explains to the Tribal Council that she was placed on the alternate list by the Housing Authority, but that she rejected being put on that list as she felt that she should be on the initial or priority list of persons eligible for homes; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the matter should be reviewed and investigated by the Housing Authority Director, and that a report should be made back to the Tribal Council on April 16, 1987, during which time the Tribal Council will meet with the Housing Authority for a full report as to the status of various projects and other issues concerning the Housing Authority.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Housing Authority Director review and investigate the eligibility status of Cyrilla (Moody) Bead for a future HUD home, and that the Director report to the Tribal Council during the April 16, 1987 Housing Authority meeting with the Tribal Council regarding his findings in respect to her eligibility and placement on the present eligibility list.

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
