

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Assistant Safety Director, Darvin Burnette, has requested Tribal Council assistance for the purchase of five radios for the Volunteer Fire Program, at a cost of \$500.00 from the Arizona State Land Department, which apparently has used radios available for the foregoing price; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Chairman should be authorized to locate funds for the purchase of the five radios.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to locate the necessary funds for the purchase of five radios at a cost of \$500.00 from the State Land Department, to be utilized by the Volunteer Fire Program.

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
