FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION




WHEREAS, George and Ramona Button, Ross and Audrey Susan have already been chosen and they have officially accepted their role of Godparents; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the Old Tribal Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Geraldine Starr, Sponsor; and George and Ramona Button, Ross and Audrey Susan, Godparents; to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of July 23, 24, 25, 26, 1987, at the old tribal fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on APRIL 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN FOR AND ZERO AGAINST by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 28, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
