


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman has been requested to authorize the use of Canyon Day land claims monies for the purchase of lights for the Canyon Day rodeo grounds; and
- WHEREAS, Councilman Herbert Tate from Canyon Day was requested to obtain bids for the purchase of said lights prior to said authorization being put into effect; and
- WHEREAS, Councilman Herbert Tate reports to the Council that he has obtained bids for the lights in the amount of \$6,950.00; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the proposal with Mr. Tate and agrees that the amount requested in the proposal should be authorized to be expended from the Canyon Day Community land claims fund.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to expend \$6,950.00 from the Canyon Day Community land claims fund for the purchase of necessary lighting for the Canyon Day rodeo grounds.

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
