RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Bill Perez, the manager of the Tribal Herd, has requested Tribal Council permission to contract out some of his longhorn steers to local rodeos as roping stock in order to generate additional revenues for the Tribal Herd and Beefmaster Program; and

WHEREAS, after explaining some of the particulars of his proposal, the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Perez should be given permission to do so.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants authorization to the manager of the Tribal Herd to contract out some of his longhorn steers to local rodeos as roping stock.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
