

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilmember Herbert Tate has presented to the Tribal Council a list of the names of individuals living in District IV to be considered as possible recipients of a house pursuant to the Home Improvement Program (H.I.P.); and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that these individuals from District IV have demonstrated a great need for the service provided by the H.I.P. Program; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the H.I.P. Advisory Committee should give special considerations to this list of names in its efforts to allocate funds pursuant to the H.I.P. Project, and a list of the names is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.



Advisory Committee that it gives special consideration to the list of names attached hereto in the allocation of funds and the selection of individuals to receive a home pursuant to the H.I.P. 
