## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilmember Herbert Tate has advised the Tribal Council that tribal member, Mr. Press Burnette, has for the last four years been scheduled to receive a Rammed Earth House pursuant to the Rammed Earth Project, but that due to delays in the Rammed Earth Project, has not as of yet, received the house; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Burnette has no house and is in dire need of a house; and
- WHEREAS, Councilmember Tate is requesting on behalf of Mr. Burnette that Mr. Burnette's name be withdrawn from the Rammed Earth Project, and that the \$7,000 of carry over funds set aside to build Mr. Burnette's house be transferred to the H.I.P. Program and there utilized to build a house for Mr. Burnette as quickly as possible.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby approves the request of Mr. Herbert Tate to remove Mr. Burnette's name from the Rammed Earth Project and transfer the \$7,000 of carry over funds set aside for construction of that house to the H.I.P. Program in order that it be utilized to build Mr. Burnette a house as quickly as is possible.

The foregoing resolution was on April 16, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
