RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney has submitted recommendations in his proposed budget for FY 87/88 for Tribal Council consideration; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney advises the Tribal Council that pursuant to his three year contract with the Tribe which expires on May 1, 1988, he is to receive a contract increase of \$5,500.00, but has advised the Tribal Chairman that he will waive said increase for FY 87/88; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney has also submitted extensive justification and documentation in support of his recommendation that the salaries of assistant tribal attorney, Scott Canty, and legal secretary, Cheryl Ricker, be adjusted accordingly; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that the detailed documentation in support of said recommendation justifies the reclassification of Cheryl Ricker as a legal secretary III, and that Scott Canty's annual salary be adjusted to reflect his achievements, responsibilities, experience and expertise as set forth in the Tribal Attorney Department's Budget.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves salary adjustments as set forth in the Tribal Attorney's budget for Scott Canty and Cheryl Ricker for FY 87/88, effective May 1, 1987.

The foregoing resolution was on April 21, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
