RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has submitted a proposed 638 Contract for Tribal Council consideration for the thinning of approximately 1,275.5 acres of overstock Ponderosa Pine Sappling and Pole Stand areas; and
- WHEREAS, members of the Tribal Council have received a copy of the proposed contract this date and have not had ample time to review it; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, although, expressing great interest in the contract, concludes that action approving said contract should be postponed until May 6, 1987, at the Tribal Council meeting.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reserves final approval of the 638 Thinning Contract until May 6, 1987, at which time the Tribal Council will take action.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby expresses its great interest in entering into such a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing resolution was on April 24, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ONE</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
