RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal member Rustin Cheney advises the Tribal Council that he has no access to his farmland, which is located south of the Post Office Canyon Bridge; and

WHEREAS, he requests that the Tribal Council designate a right-of-way to his farmland; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants to Rustin Cheney a right-of-way and access road to his farmland, located south of the Post Office Canyon Bridge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests that Mr. Raymus Albert of the Tribal Land Board survey and lay out an appropriate right-of-way and access road to Mr. Cheney's farmland.

The foregoing resolution was on May 13, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a) & (h) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
