

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has extended an invitation to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, to participate in the state conducted Food Stamp Delivery Management Consulting Services Program of the Arizona Department of Economic Security - Family Assistance Administration for eligible persons; and
- WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is a great need on the reservation for the direct delivery of food stamps; and
- WHEREAS, by use of these identified funds the Food Stamp Delivery Management Consulting Services Program can assist individuals in need of direct food stamp delivery services in all districts on the reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has received Notification of a Grant Award for FY 87-88 commencing July 1, 1987 in the submitted negotiable amount of \$26,233; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to accept the negotiated amount and any other grant award hereafter; and
- WHEREAS, said program funds will be used to provide delivery services to food stamp recipients.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the FY 87 Grant Award for the Food Stamp Delivery/Management Consulting Services Program and any other grant award hereafter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman or his authorized delegate is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Arizona Department of Economic Security - Family Assistance

Administration, and any other parties appropriate and necessary for participation by the Tribe in the aforescribed Food Stamp Delivery Management Consulting Services Program.

The foregoing resolution was on May 13, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
