## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Roads, has appeared before the Tribal Council and requested permission to survey Route 12(20) from the Cibecue/Grasshopper district boundary to the Oak Creek turnout, a distance of 4.75 miles; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that such a survey should be conducted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Roads to survey Route 12(20) as indicated herein.

The foregoing resolution was on May 14, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
