

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency, has formerly transferred three BIA quarters, #32, #209 and #203 to the Tribe and that formal acceptance by the Tribe of the transfer is necessary to finalize tribal ownership of the homes; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to the Tribal Council that the three BIA dwellings, #32, #209 and #203 be accepted by the Tribal Council and the Tribal Council concurs in said recommendation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the transfer of ownership from the Bureau of Indian Affairs of three Agency dwellings designated as #32, #209 and #203 to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 14, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (j)(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
