RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised by the Tribal Election commission that the Commission intends to organize and conduct a Voter Registration Drive during the months of June through September 1987; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been further advised that the Voter Registration Drive will allow the Tribal Council Secretary and the Office of Vital Statistics to update the tribe's eligible voters list and the tribe's enrollment records and will thereby build a foundation for a more efficient and orderly tribal election in the spring of 1988; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that funds for the Voter Registration Drive have been allocated in the budget request of the Tribal Election Commission.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Election Commission to organize and stage a Voter Registration Drive on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation during the months of June through September 1987.

The foregoing resolution was on May 14, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a)(s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
