
RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is committed to delivery of quality mental health services for its tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has in previous years been funded for these mental health services under a P. L. 93-638 contract with Indian Health Services.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Phoenix Area Indian Health Services office grant a one year contract beginning October 1, 1987, and ending September 30, 1988, for the full mental health service functions at the Whiteriver Public Health Service Unit.

The foregoing resolution was on JULY 9, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE FOR AND ZERO AGAINST by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
