RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous resolution directed that a proposed amendment to the Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO) Ordinance be posted for public comment for a minimum of ten days as required by the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the proposed amendment, a copy of which is attached hereto, has been posted publicly by the Tribal Council Secretary for more than the ten days requirement and that there has not been any objections or comments from the public in respect to final passage of the proposed ordinance; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that final passage of the proposed amendment will further the health, safety and employment development goals of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby approves final passage of the
 Tribal Employment Rights Fee amendment to be effective
 immediately in the form attached hereto and by incorporated
 by reference herein.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JULY 9, 1987</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN FOR AND ZERO AGAINST</u> by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
