RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION



- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Thomas Banashley and family as sponsors, and Nashley and Verna Tessay, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Sheree Mae Banashley during the weekend of September 25, 26, 27, 1987, in Canyon Day.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JULY 23, 1987</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT FOR AND ZERO AGAINST</u> by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat.-984).
