RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission has previously received by Council resolution an approved budget in the amount of \$25,000 to be used in carrying out its duties as assigned by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission has proposed to the Tribal Council that a Voter Registration Drive be conducted and the Tribal Council has previously given its approval for a Voter Registration Drive and the Election Commission advises the Council that as part of the registration process a voter identification card will be issued to each tribal member who registers to vote, said card including a photo identification of the registered voter; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission wishes to purchase the necessary equipment for producing laminated voter identification cards and has presented to the Council a demonstration by Bender Associates Incorporated, the lowest of three bidders investigated by the Commission; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the proposal of the Tribal Election Commission and has viewed the demonstration presented by Bender Associates Incorporated and is of the opinion that the purchase of the equipment is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission now requires a modification to its budget to allow for the purchase of this photo identification equipment.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby modifies the budget of the Tribal Election Commission to allow for the expenditure of funds already appropriated to the Election Commission budget for the purchase of the above referenced equipment and further authorizes the Election Commission to enter into any agreements necessary for the purchase of the equipment.
