

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilmember Herbert Tate has brought to the attention of the Council, certain on-going problems concerning the location and operation of the Tribal liquor store; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Tate has informed the Council that there are safety problems arising out of the location of the liquor store, and certain other aesthetic and public relations factors which suggest that it may be appropriate to relocate the liquor store; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the feasibility of relocating the liquor store should be investigated.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints a committee which is comprised of the following individuals to investigate the feasibility of relocating the liquor store: Councilmember Herbert Tate, Councilmember Nelson Ethelbah, Councilmember Kino Kane, Councilmember Darwin Burnette, Councilmember Judy Dehose, and BIA Superintendent Russell Bradley. This committee shall investigate the feasibility of relocating the liquor store and shall report to the Tribal Council as soon as the feasibility study is complete.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a),(i),(s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
