RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN AFACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has by previous Resolution No. 08-87-264, established a special committee to investigate the feasibility of relocating the tribal liquor store; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that this feasibility study should be coordinated with the Tribal Judicial Branch and the Tribal Law Enforcement Division in order to get their input on the proposal.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the committee established by the above referenced resolution is hereby directed to meet with the Tribal Judicial Branch and the Law Enforcement Division in order to determine a mutual recommendation concerning the proposed relocation of the Tribal Liquor Store, which recommendation shall be reported to the Tribal Council at the September Council Meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a),(i),(s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
