

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has by previous Resolution No. 06-87-192 designated the Smith Cienega area as a wilderness area and has placed restrictions on its use; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Darvin Burnette has informed the Tribal Council that the correct identification of the Smith Cienega area should be "Bull Cienega" and has asked that the prior Resolution be amended to reflect this more accurate designation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 06-87-192 is hereby amended by substituting "Bull Cienega" in place of "Smith Cienega", and in all future resolutions concerning this area it shall be known as "Bull Cienega" and not as "Smith Cienega".

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a), (m) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
