RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Home Improvement Program Coordinator that the balance of the Pammed Earth Funds need to be obligated; and
- WHEREAS, the fiscal year is almost over and these funds can be used to build one additional house under the current contract; and
- WHEREAS, it has been proposed that Mr. Jackson Gatewood be added to the list as a qualifying applicants from District I, and receive a house to be built from the balance of the Rammed Earth funds.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Jackson Gatewood is hereby added to the list of qualifying applicants on the current contract for District I, and shall receive a house to be built from the balance of the Rammed Earth funds. Construction shall start as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on September 1, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
