- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Upper Cibecue.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Nashley and Verna Tessay, Sponsors, and Mr. & Mrs. Hupp Sanchez, Jr., and Mr. & Mrs. Harrison Burnette, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Verneva and Ethelena Tessay during the weekend of June 2, 3, 4, 5, 1988, in Upper Cibecue.

The foregoing resolution was on November 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) (g) & (h) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
