BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Che Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mr. and Mrs. Rudy Walker, Sr., Sponsors, and Guy and Yvonna (Alchesay) Redsteer, Godparents to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Randallyn Aday during the weekend of July 22, 23, 24, 1988 in Whiteriver at the old tribal fairgrounds.

The foregoing resolution was on November 4, 1987,1 duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) (g) & (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (Stat. 984).
