RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Tribal Ordinance Number 59, the Director of Tribal Enrollment for the White Mountain Apache Tribe has recommended to the Tribal Council that each individual whose name appears on the attached list and who has applied for membership into the White Mountain Apache Tribe be accepted as a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, each person listed on the attached list qualifies for membership and it is recommended that their membership status be approved because their parents or legal quardians did not file enrollment applications within one year of the date of their birth; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the applicant list and concurs with the recommendation that the persons listed be granted membership status.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the twenty-two applicants on the attached list are hereby enrolled into the membership of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on November 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Interior on June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
