


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Acting Director of the Tribal Health Authority, Hedy Beatty, has advised the Tribal Council that pursuant to Tribal Personnel Policies several salaried employees of the White Mountain Apache Emergency Medical Services Program (E.M.S.) have not been paid for certain of their annual leave time which was accrued during the last fiscal year and these employees have been advised by the Tribal Personnel Department that they have, "lost" this annual leave time and will not be paid for it, and the Health Authority Director is asking for a waiver of the Tribal Personnel Policy in order that the EMS employees may be compensated for annual leave not taken; and

WHEREAS, these employees are routinely required to work overtime without overtime pay and the Tribal Council is of the opinion that these employees should be compensated for this "lost" annual leave time and that this compensation should be paid out of program carryover funds during this current year.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes payment out of program carryover funds of the EMS Program of all "lost" annual leave time for which employees of the EMS Program have not been paid during the 1986-87 fiscal year. The Personnel Department and the Comptroller's Office are hereby authorized to make the necessary arrangement.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
