

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Buddy Boni has come before the Tribal Council with a complaint against an off-reservation merchant, Bailey's Feed & Supply Company, and has alleged that Bailey's Feed is attempting to collect a debt through the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court which Mr. Boni maintains he does not owe to Bailey's Feed and which arises out of a contractual transaction which in Mr. Boni's opinion, Bailey's Feed has not honored; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Boni has requested the Council's further assistance in this matter.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Attorney, is hereby directed to advise Mr. Boni concerning his rights in this matter and pursue as far as possible a resolution of this matter in Mr. Boni's favor.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
