WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has previously established an interdisciplinary team to advise and make recommendations on tribal timber sales; and


WHEREAS, said Committee is composed of the following individuals: Erv Kulosa, White Mountain Apache Forester; Wilkie Gregg, Chairman, Forestry Committee; John Caid, White Mountain Apache Game & Fish; David Reinhold, B.I.A. Forest Manager; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council that a council member should be appointed to serve on the interdisciplinary team and Council Member Ray Ivans has demonstrated an interest in forestry issues and is willing to serve on the team.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby appoints Council Member Ray Ivans as the fifth member of the Interdisciplinary Team with the responsibility of reporting periodically to the Tribal Council on the activities and recommendations of the Team.

The foregoing resolution was on December 14, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) & (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
