

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Christmas holiday season is now here and the Tribal Council wishes to spread some additional Christmas cheer among the children of our communities in the form of a Christmas candy distribution; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in the Land Claims Accounts of each of the reservation communities in sufficient quantities to provide for the candy distribution.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$1,500 is hereby appropriated from each of the community land claim funds in order to finance a Christmas candy distribution in each of the communities.

The foregoing resolution was on December 14, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) & (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
